



ANNUAL ACTIVITY REPORT 2025 MACEDONIAN ESPORTS FEDERATION

1. INTRODUCTION

This Annual Activity Report outlines the work and activities of the Macedonian Esports Federation during the year 2025.

The year 2025 was characterized as a period of consolidation, strategic focus, and international performance. MESF concentrated its efforts on maintaining organizational stability, preparing national teams, and ensuring strong international representation, in line with its strategic objectives and statutory responsibilities.

2. GOVERNANCE AND ORGANIZATIONAL STABILITY

Throughout 2025, MESF operated in accordance with its Statute and national legislation.

No extraordinary General Assembly was convened during the year, as there were no statutory changes, leadership changes, or urgent governance matters requiring such action. The existing governance structure remained fully functional and stable.

The Executive Board continued to oversee federation activities, ensuring continuity, compliance, and alignment with MESF's long-term strategic objectives.

3. SPORTING ACTIVITIES AND COMPETITIONS

During 2025, MESF focused primarily on international representation rather than domestic competition organization.

No national championships were organized during the year, as the strategic priority was placed on preparation and participation in international competitions.

National teams were selected directly based on performance, eligibility, and competitive readiness, in line with international competition requirements and timelines.

4. INTERNATIONAL ACHIEVEMENTS

The highlight of the 2025 sporting year was the outstanding performance of the Macedonian National Team at the European Esports Championship 2025 in Pristina, Kosovo.

The national team achieved first place in the Dota 2 competition, winning the European Esports Championship title. This result represents a historic achievement for Macedonian esports and confirms the effectiveness of MESF's athlete selection and preparation process.

The victory significantly strengthened the international visibility and credibility of MESF and the Republic of North Macedonia within the European esports community.



5. NATIONAL TEAM MANAGEMENT

MESF managed and supported national teams through:

- Direct selection procedures based on competitive merit
- Administrative and logistical coordination
- Communication with international organizers
- Representation of national interests at international events

The focus remained on quality, professionalism, and competitive readiness rather than quantity of activities.

6. INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION

During 2025, the Macedonian Esports Federation was officially represented at the General Assembly of the International Esports Federation, held in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia.

MESF actively participated in the General Assembly proceedings and formally supported the election of the new IESF President, reaffirming its commitment to international cooperation, institutional stability, and the development of esports at the global level.

7. INTEGRITY, GOVERNANCE, AND COMPLIANCE

MESF continued to operate in accordance with principles of transparency, integrity, and good governance.

The Federation adhered to:

- Its Statute and internal regulations
- National sports legislation
- International esports standards
- Principles of fair play and ethical conduct

No disciplinary or governance issues were recorded during the year.

8. COMMUNICATION AND PUBLIC PRESENCE

Throughout 2025, MESF maintained communication with stakeholders through official channels and public announcements related to national team participation and international results.

The European Championship victory received positive public attention and contributed to the promotion of esports at the national level.
